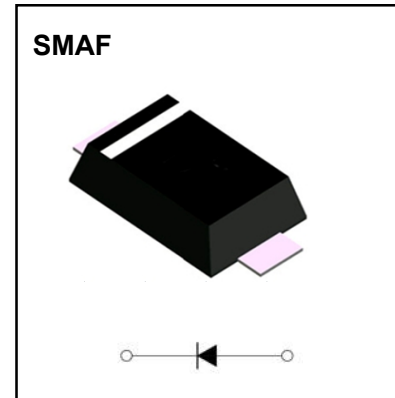

FIG.1: FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

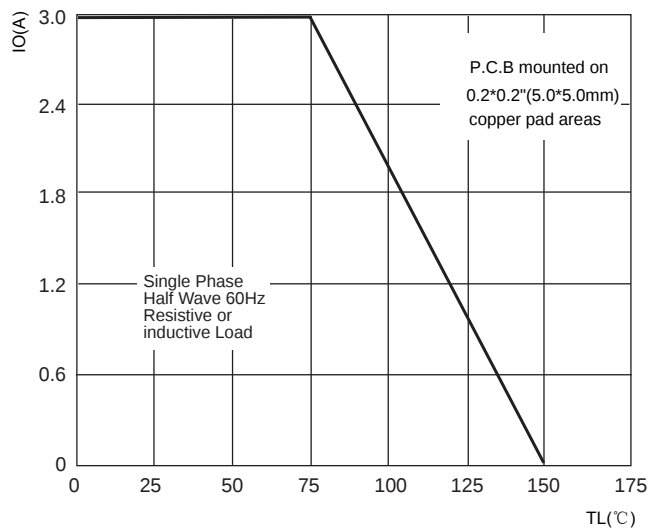


FIG2: Surge Forward Current Capability

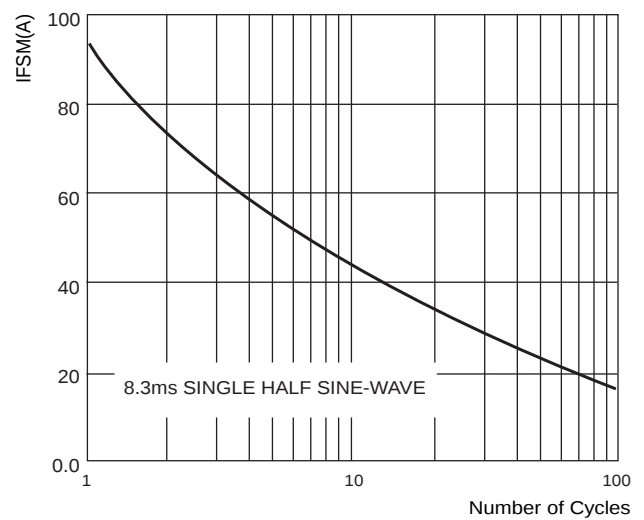


FIG.3: TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

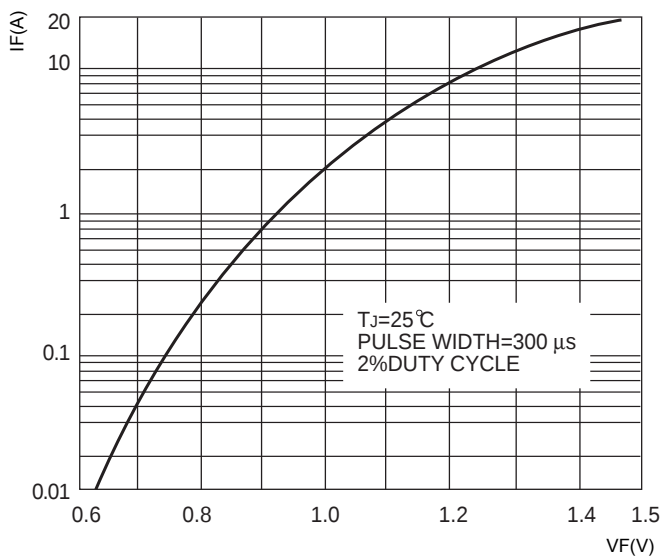
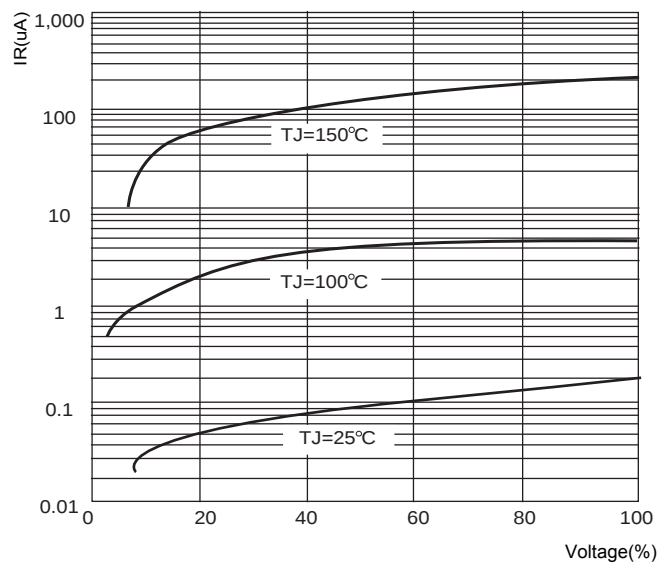
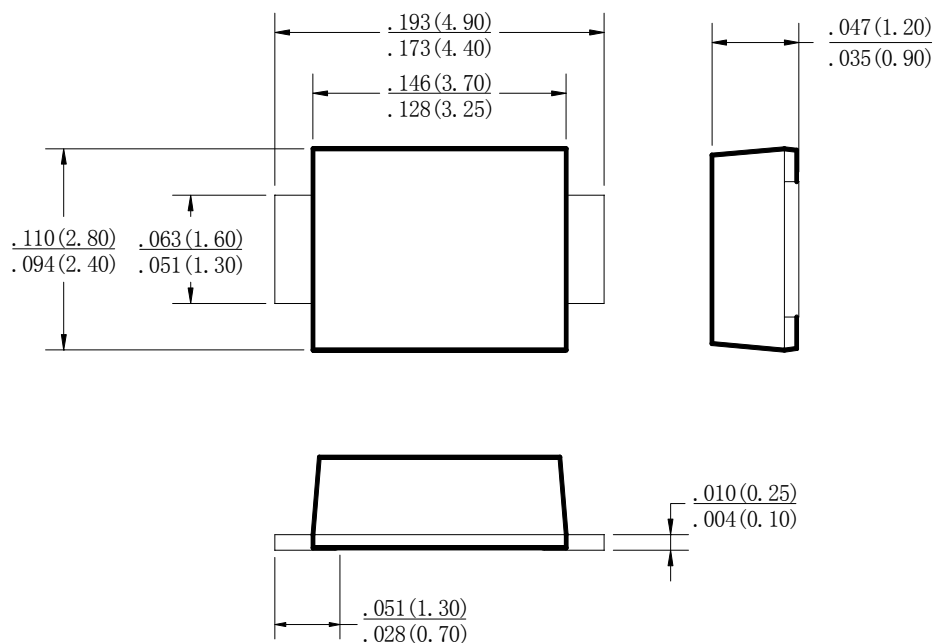


FIG.4 : TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

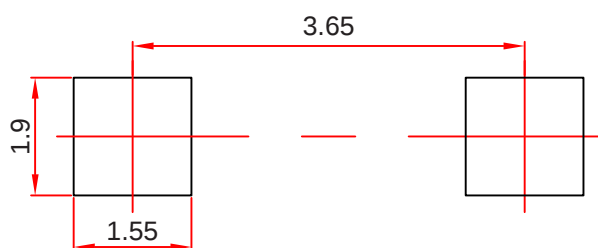


SMAF Package Outline Dimensions
